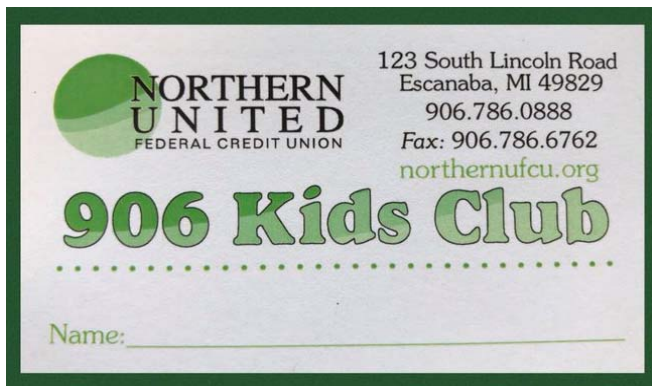

Important Safety Tips: In March of 2018, Equifax confirmed 2.4 million consumers' credit card credentials were affected by the data breach. This past July, Equifax claims they discovered evidence of cybercrime events. Here are some ways to protect yourself against identity theft/fraud:

- Change account passwords. Be sure to use complex passwords that include upper- & lower-case letters, numbers and special symbols.
- Shop with a credit card, especially when shopping online.
- Monitor account activity and statements regularly.
- Shred unneeded documents.
- Stay updated on common scams and warning signs.
- Keep personal information confidential. Don't give out personal information over the phone, through email or over the internet.
